SJM for Grand Lisboa Palace



Award-winning **Grand Lisboa Palace Resort Macau** (“Grand Lisboa Palace”) of SJM Resorts, S.A. The European-styled garden is centred around an ornate dome that illuminates the area with an ethereal glow after sunset. The area also features grass mazes with a baroque opulence and lawns flanked by elegant pavilions and a colonnade. Shaped by perfectly manicured greens, landscaped patios and gazebos, this inspiring outdoor venue is an exceptional location for hosting private and commercial events ranging from intimate ceremonies and banquets to cocktail parties or product launches.



Grand Lisboa Palace's ornate East-meets-West aesthetic pays stunning tribute to Macau's rich heritage. Its exquisitely furnished interior presents a harmonious interplay of Chinese and Western design and element, creating a modern yet storied ambience depicting Macau's unique cultural identity.



Inviting the public to explore and encounter a world where art is seamlessly woven into Grand Lisboa Palace's East-West fabric, the resort features a distinguished collection of artistically and historically significant art pieces; including a wealth of locally commissioned art works, antiquities, and cultural art pieces. One of the exceptional pieces is the "Tian Gong Ci Fu" Clock with Water Automaton and Musical Mechanism from the Qing Imperial Palace, an exquisite 19th-century foreign timepiece exemplifying the mechanical clocks highly prized by Chinese emperors during the Ming and Qing dynasties.



The resort's "GLP Sculpture Gallery" also showcases artistic gems from the SJM collection, celebrating the Lisboa brand's local heritage and SJM's enduring vision for cultural preservation.

Through professional curatorship of its art collection, SJM offers public a window into the city's vibrant art scene at Grand Lisboa Palace, to enrich the cultural engagement for both residents and visitors.

From the unique KARL Kameo artwork at the lobby reception and commissioned furniture, to Chinoiserie-inspired room décor and modern interpretation of traditional craftsmanship; each pattern, material and decoration is personally conceived or selected by the designer himself. Palazzo Versace Macau is evocative of an Italian Palazzo that Versace's Milanese heritage and signature luxury are immediately evident and fully immersive. The hotel showcases the best of Versace craftsmanship, design and iconic style, it invites guests to step into Versace's way of life.



Guests are welcomed at the lobby by a magnificent representation of Versace's home in Milan, the Palazzo at Via Gesù that houses the Versace Atelier. The iconic Medusa head and an energetic clash of rich Classical influences from Baroque and ancient Greek culture throughout - whether across lush custom carpets, as decorative sculpted finishes, or incorporated into terrazzo floors and mosaics handcrafted by Fantini Mosaici. The chrysanthemum flower and ornate dragon motifs appear within the hotel are symbols rooted in local Chinese custom and interplay throughout the Italianate aesthetic in a design expression unique to Palazzo Versace Macau.
